Rules & Regulations

1. Exhibitors entering prior to August 13th will receive one Vehicle Pass which will admit their vehicle and up to 2 people on to the Showground.
2. Entries will be accepted on the day. Please note driver and passengers will be charged the normal admission price ie £9.00 per adult and £7.50 for concessions.
3. Vehicles should access the Showground via Gate 2, adjacent the Queens Head on Main Road, Watnall.
4. To comply with our insurance requirements owners are asked to be in place by 10.00am each day. For the same reason vehicles WILL NOT be able to leave the Showground until at least 4.30pm each day. This is a Police and Insurance as well as a Health & Safety requirement and will be strictly enforced.
5. Camping and Caravan space is available, free of charge, but must be booked when you enter your vehicles. Provided they are purchased before August 13th discounted tickets are available - Family Tickets £15 for two adults and up to six children and Adult tickets £7.50 instead of £9.00.
6. There will be a parade of Classic Vehicles in the Main Ring on both days. Please indicate on the entry form if you wish to participate.
7. Motor clubs wanting to put on a group display are welcome. They should ensure all their vehicles enter the Showground in convoy as it is not possible to reserve space once other vehicles start entering the display area.
